**Sub: Conducting lateral entry test for admission in class XI.**

Respected Sir

Though we do not want our regular children to leave the JNV after completing class X examination successfully, we cannot stop them from doing so for various reasons. Consequently, JNVs are inviting applications from other local schools in the district from the students desirous of studying + 2 course in our JNVs. The regional offices are gathering the data of the applicants and granting admission on the basis of scores in class X.

The students who are admitted on the basis of marks turn out to be ordinary and the JNVs are sadly facing a mammoth challenge in helping the children cope with our academic work and reach the benchmarks, which are usually high. In order to make the entry more competitive as well as further propagate the scheme of NVS in the districts, the Association requests the Hon'ble Commissioner to make arrangements for an entrance examination for lateral entry at Class XI too.

This examination may be conducted on the lines of class IX lateral entry utilizing the services of Principals who excel in subjects like English, Maths, Physics, and Commerce etc. The regional offices may be instructed to obtain the data of available seats by the second week of June and make arrangements for the lateral test in the first week of July. However, the test may also be conducted to fill the assumed vacant seats. The test results may be made available by the middle of July and admissions may be done in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> week of July. A good coordination between the JNVs and the regional offices will definitely help the admission process to be completed in time so that the fresh admittants do not lose more academic time.

The Association requests the Hon'ble Commissioner to consider this proposal positively.
